Since the last update, the renovations have progressed at pace and, as you can see below, we are going to have a large, usable and wonderful space:



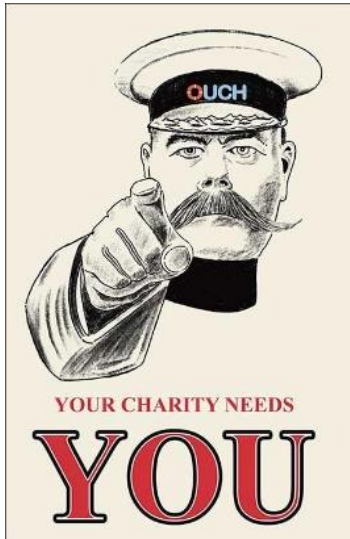

The flooding damage has meant the floor will have to be replaced and this is now the priority. Our hope is that we will have a useable hall for the May Bank Holiday.

Once the hall remedial work is complete, next on the agenda is replacing the toilets with separate facilities for Ladies and Gents.

In the meantime, we are seeking volunteers with the relevant skills to help with the following two tasks:



1. To improve the front of the hall by stripping and painting the fence and gate.

2. To create temporary storage by making two of the sheds useable.

This will entail clearing the contents, removing the vegetation around them, and doing what is necessary to make them watertight.

The charity can provide all necessary materials.

We have already secured a like-for-like £15,000 grant from Buckinghamshire Council which will help us finish the immediate renovations. We are going to need a lot more money for the second stage and will be in touch seeking ideas for local fund raising to support grant applications at a later date.
